MAY BANK HOLIDAY


School will be closed on Monday 6th May for the bank holiday.






Well done to 4MC who achieved 100% last week.



On Friday 3rd May the children will be invited to participate in the colour dash at school. A separate letter and sponsorship form will be sent home with children.






EMPATHY AUTHORS BOOK COLLECTION










The main driving gate on Towers Drive is closed between 8.30-8.55am and 3.05-3.35pm.


